





Advantages of dual polarization radar: The top image shows a WSR-88D vertical cross-section of radar reflectivity; the bottom image shows how dualpolarization techniques can better identify and quantify precipitation types and areas. The bottom color scale progresses from light, moderate, to heavy rain through rain/hail mix, graupel/sleet, hail, dry and wet snow, and ice.


