

#### **BREAKING NEWS...**

- New NOAA climate model shows southwestern Australia's long-term rainfall decline due to human-caused climate change. Model improves regional precipitation predictions more broadly
- Tropical cyclones reach maximum intensity closer to the poles
- First evidence that acidity of continental shelf waters off the West Coast is dissolving the shells of pteropods


# Status of the U.S. Fisheries 2013

Efforts to reauthorize Magnuson-Stevens Act under way




#### Science @ the Interface of Climate Change/Stock Assessment

- Promote collaboration among researchers, resource managers, businesses and the public












