### **Summary of Recommendation Response**

- 13/15 recommendations concurrence or partial concurrence
  - For two wildfire recommendations, NOAA agreed on vision,
     but NOAA is not lead agency for the proposed efforts
- NOAA responses outline current activities/next steps that NOAA is pursuing supporting the recommendation



## **NOAA Actions since Report Release**

- NWS/NIDIS improved messaging in Drought Information Statements
- Launch of two NIHHIS Centers of Excellence
- Launch of NWS/CDC <u>heat risk forecasts</u>
- Climate Adaptive Drought Planning (CADP) platform prototype in development
- S2S to decadal wildland fire risk information products in development
- Western Hydroclimate Program Plan and Study nearing completion



#### Opportunities to Respond to the Challenges Embedded in the SAB Recommendations

- NOAA is challenged to reach all communities in need of services and to deliver the full range of requirements for interdisciplinary information.
- Partnerships with state and local governments, other Federal agencies, associations and others, expands reach and impact of NOAA's climate information.
- Efforts underway to follow through on NOAA's Equitable Climate Services Action Plan.
- Climate Ready Nation is an initiative for NOAA to better coordinate, develop, and deliver a range of climate services.
